PLAYER PLACEMENT:

Players are placed on teams by the Youth Hockey Director. The Hockey Director reserves the right to adjust teams as deemed necessary in order to level the playing field between teams in each age division. Siblings in the same age groups will be permitted to play on the same team. Carpool requests will also be considered as long as it does not interfere with the even distribution of the teams. The Coach's child will be placed with him/her. Female players and goalies will be permitted to play in a lower division if requested.

LEAGUE FORMAT:

All games, practices and skills sessions are at Corona Inline. You will be contacted by rink staff with the team your player is on & the first practice..

10 games plus playoffs (all teams will make playoffs). Top 2 teams get prizes. Also includes 4 half rink practices and 2 skills clinics. 6-Under is 8 games plus championship game and 7 skills clinics.

TEAM STRUCTURE:

Each team will have a maximum of 10 skaters and goalie. All Corona Inline leagues strive for equal playing time.

GAME FORMAT:

Games are usually played during the week at either 5:30pm, 6:25pm or 7:20pm. Some games will be held on Saturdays. Practices and Skills Sessions are on Saturdays. Games are three 15 minute periods.

REQUIRED EQUIPMENT:

- Elbow Pad and Knee/Shin Pads, Gloves
- Stick & Skates (no brakes)
- Protective cup/pelvic protector (boys & girls)
- Corona Inline home/away jerseys (additional \$50 cost)
